KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



SHRI PALANIAPPAN CHIDAMBARAM
HOME MINISTER, GOVERNMENT OF INDIA

P. Chidambaram is currently the Minister of Home Affairs in the Government of India, a position he has held since December 2008 (following the terror attacks in Mumbai in November 2008). Prior to this, from 2004-2008, Mr. Chidambaram was the Finance Minister of India, a period during which he helped cement India's progress towards economic reforms and accelerated economic growth. He was also the Finance Minister previously from 1996 to 1998. A lawyer by training, Mr. Chidambaram is a member of the All India Congress Committee, has been a Member of Parliament since 1984, and has held positions of political leadership including Minister of State for Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions (1986-1989); Minister of State for Internal Security (1986-1989); and Minister of State for Commerce (1991-1992 and 1995-1996).

SALMAN KHURSHID
MINISTER OF STATE, GOVERNMENT OF INDIA

Salman Khurshid is serving as India's Minister of State for Corporate Affairs and for Minority Affairs since 2009, the latest in a long series of positions of political leadership. Since he was first elected as a Member of Parliament in 1991, Mr. Khurshid has held appointments including the Deputy Minister of Commerce (1991), the Minister of State for External Affairs (1993-1996), and the Chairman of the Department of Foreign Affairs (1996-1997). He has played a prominent role within the Indian National Congress, particularly on minority affairs, and is a visible spokesman for the Congress party, where he has led the Uttar Pradesh Congress Committee (1999-2000 and 2005-2008), the Department of Policy Planning and Coordination (2000-2003) and served as General Secretary, All India Congress Committee (2004-2005). A lawyer and law professor by training, Mr. Khurshid has taught at Trinity College, Oxford and has practised law with leading firms in India. He has published several legal articles and is also the author of books on the issues of Kashmir and Muslims in India. Mr. Khurshid was elected a Global Leader of Tomorrow by the World Economic Forum at Davos in 1995.



SH. NANDAN NILEKANI
CHAIRMAN (UIDAI)

Nandan Nilekani is the Chairman of the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) in the rank of Union Cabinet Minister. UIDAI aims to provide a unique identification number for all residents of India. Mr. Nilekani was most recently the Co-Chairman of the Board of Directors of Infosys Technologies Limited, which he co-founded in 1981. He served as Director on the Company's Board since its inception until July 2009. He has held various posts at Infosys, including Chief Executive Officer and Managing Director, President, and Chief Operating Officer. He co-founded India's National Association of Software and Service Companies (NASSCOM) as well as the Bangalore chapter of the IndUS Entrepreneurs (TiE). He is a member of the Board of Governors of the Indian Council for Research on International Economic Relations (ICRIER) and the President of NCEAR (the premier, independent, applied economics research Institute in India). Born in Bangalore, he received his Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering from the Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay. He was named the Corporate Citizen of the Year at the Asia Business Leaders Award (2004) organized by CNBC. In 2005, he received the prestigious Joseph Schumpeter Prize for innovative services in economy, economic sciences and politics. In 2006, he was awarded the distinguished Padma Bhushan award by the Indian Government and was also named Businessman of the Year by Forbes Asia. Time magazine listed him as one of the 100 most influential people in the world in 2006 and 2009. He is the author of 'Imagining India', which was one of the finalists for the FT-Goldman Sachs Book Award for the year 2009.

DEEPAK PAREKH
CHAIRMAN, IDFC

Deepak Parekh is the Chairman of HDFC Ltd., India's premier housing finance company, which he joined in 1978 as Deputy General Manager. He was appointed Chairman in 1993. HDFC's growth in stature and strength since its inception has been achieved by a steadfast focus on sound values such as integrity, transparency and professionalism, and underpinned by a basic sense of trust from the Indian middle-class. His farsightedness has not only made HDFC the leader in mortgages, but also transformed it into a financial conglomerate with presence in banking, asset management, life insurance, general insurance and a real estate venture fund. Mr. Parekh has often been called the unofficial crisis consultant of the Government of India. Be it his recent role as Special Director on the Satyam Board to revive the company or the crucial role played by him during the UTI debacle (late 90s) to recommend measures for sustaining investor confidence, it is this quality of a master trouble-shooter that makes him a guiding force and an active member of various high-powered Economic Groups, Government-appointed Advisory Committees and Task Forces which includes housing, financial services, capital markets and infrastructure sector reforms. He received India's distinguished Padma Bhushan award in 2006. His other awards include Most Inspiring Business Leader Award by NDTV Profit in 2010, a Lifetime Achievement Award by the Confederation of Real Estate Developers Associations of India (CREDAI) for his contribution to the Real Estate Industry 2010, Outstanding Business Leader of the Year 2008 by CNBC, NDTV Business Leader of the Year Award 2008, Lifetime Achievement Award by The Economic Times in 2006, the first international award of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales' Outstanding Achievement Award 2010. Besides HDFC Group Companies, he is the Non-Executive Chairman of GlaxoSmithkline Pharmaceuticals, Infrastructure Development Finance Company (IDFC), Lafarge India and Siemens India Ltd. He is also on the boards of Castrol India Limited, Hindustan Oil Exploration Co. Ltd., Hindustan Unilever Limited, Mahindra & Mahindra Limited, Indian Hotels Company Limited, WNS Global Services Pvt. Ltd. (USA) and the Airports Authority of India.





DR. RAJIV LALL
MANAGING DIRECTOR & CEO, IDFC

Dr. Rajiv Lall is the Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer of IDFC. He has held this post since January 2005. Dr. Lall has over two decades of experience with leading global investment banks, multilateral agencies and in academia. His areas of expertise include project finance, private equity/ venture capital, international capital markets, trade and macroeconomic policy issues with a focus on India and China. He has a number of publications to his credit.

Prior to joining IDFC, Dr. Lall was variously, a Partner with Warburg Pincus in New York, Head of Asian Economic Research, with Morgan Stanley Asia Limited, and Economist with the World Bank, Washington DC and the Asian Development Bank (ADB), Manila, Philippines and a member faculty of Florida Atlantic University.

Dr. Lall has a BA in Politics, Philosophy and Economics from Oxford University and a Ph.D. in Economics from Columbia University.

AMEET H. DESAI
EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR & CFO, ADANI POWER

Ameet Desai is the Executive Director & CFO of Adani Power Ltd. (APL). His diverse experience of over 23 years is across three sectors and five businesses comprising of strategy formulation and execution, corporate finance, resource mobilization, running business operations, building and managing organisations at different stages of evolution, international buy side and sell side transactions, board management, corporate spokespersonship, JV partner and other critical relationship management. At the Adani Group, Mr. Desai has been instrumental in several strategic and operational initiatives for the port, SEZ & logistics, power and City Gas Distribution businesses in the areas of Finance, Accounts, Taxation, Secretarial, Legal and IT. He successfully led two infrastructure sector IPOs and within 21 months, raising over US\$1 billion of equity. He also co-led the share placement of Adani Enterprises the largest QIP offering in 2010 and has mobilized debt of over USD 8.5 bn. Prior to joining the Adani Group, Mr. Desai was Vice President (M&A and Business Planning) at Ranbaxy Laboratories and also worked as VP-Corporate at Core Healthcare where he ran the operations for nearly two years.

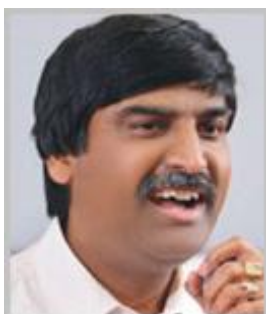


ARVIND BHATNAGAR
CEO, GATEWAY TERMINALS INDIA PVT. LTD.

Arvind Bhatnagar is the Chief Executive Officer of Gateway Terminals India (GTI), a world-class terminal operator at Mumbai's Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust. In this role, he has overseen record berth productivity, the highest throughput registered in India in 2008 and the highest number of trains handled within a 24-hour period. Under his leadership, GTI was awarded Lloyd's Terminal of the Year in 2007 and 2009, the Economic Times' award in 2008 for a "Smart Workplace" and the Container Terminal of the Year by IIMLE. Prior to joining GTI, Mr. Bhatnagar was with the Container Corporation of India (Western Region) where he played a pivotal role in decongesting the port through the implementation of a rail network. He began his career with the Indian Railway Traffic Service in 1982 where, over a period of 20 years, he held key positions at the operational and commercial levels and was associated with the conversion of the meter to broad gauge in the Western Railways, as also with the Passengers Reservation system in Mumbai region.

VINAYAK CHATTERJEE
CHAIRMAN, FEEDBACK VENTURES (P) LIMITED

Vinayak Chatterjee is the Chairman of Feedback Ventures (Feedback), which he co-founded in 1990. Feedback Ventures is India's leading integrated infrastructure services company with four divisions: infrastructure advisory; transportation; realty & townships; and energy. Mr. Chatterjee is often called upon to play a strategic advisory role to leading Indian companies, the Government of India, various Ministries dealing with infrastructure, State Governments, as well as multi-lateral and bilateral institutions in the areas of infrastructure planning and implementation. He is one of the leading proponents of the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model for developing India's infrastructure through his steering of the successful India Infrastructure Initiative a partnership between IDFC and Feedback Ventures. In 1998, the World Economic Forum at Davos selected him as one of the 100 Global Leaders of Tomorrow. He is the current Chairman of the Confederation of Indian Industry's (CII) National Council on Urbanization and Future Cities and has chaired the CII's National Council on Infrastructure (2003-06, 2007-09), CII's National Committee on Urban Infrastructure (2001-03) and was the Chairman of CII (Northern Region) for 2000-2001. He is on the Boards of SRF Limited and Avantha Power and Infrastructure Limited, and is on the Advisory Board of HDFC India Realty Fund.



I. PRABHAKARA RAO
CEO, GMR, AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT

Mr. I. Prabhakara Rao is the Chief Executive Officer - Airport Development of Delhi International Airport Limited (DIAL), India's largest and most modern airport being developed by the GMR Group. DIAL has implemented a world-class terminal in a record time of 37 months with Asia's longest runway. During his tenure with the GMR Group, Mr. Rao has been instrumental in setting up the world largest 200 MW diesel based power plant at Chennai and the commissioning and operating of a 388.5 MW gas based power project at Vemagiri. Before joining the GMR Group in 1995, he worked with Durgapur Steel Plant, Usha Fans and Regency Ceramics.

M.K. SINHA**PRESIDENT & CEO, IDFC PROJECT EQUITY**

Mr. M.K. Sinha ("MK") is an investment professional with over 20 years of experience. He is the President & CEO of IDFC Project Equity Company Limited that manages the US\$ 927 MM "India Infrastructure Fund." His earlier role at IDFC between 2005 and 2007 was as an Executive Director with responsibility for Business Development & Project Finance. Prior to joining IDFC, Mr. Sinha worked with the General Electric Company in the Structured Finance Group for over 10 years across US, London, Hong Kong and Singapore. Before that, he worked with Bank of America and SBI Capital Markets in the Corporate Finance and Investment Banking areas respectively. Mr. Sinha holds a Masters in Business Administration from the Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad, and a B.Tech (Hons.) in Mechanical Engineering from the Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur.

**DR. VIKAS AMTE****SECRETARY & CHIEF FUNCTIONARY, MAHAROGI SEWA SAMITI, WARORA (ANANDWAN)**

Dr. Vikas Murlidhar Amte is the son of Baba Amte, the distinguished social worker. A medical doctor by profession, Dr. Amte has volunteered to carry forward the unfinished Mission of Compassion initiated by his father. Since 2003, he has been the Secretary (Chief Functionary) of Maharogi Sewa Samiti, Warora, a Public Charitable Trust established in the year 1949 for the treatment, training and rehabilitation of leprosy-afflicted people. Dr. Amte is a resourceful and versatile social worker responsible for ushering in a number of disabled-friendly, eco-friendly, cost effective, innovative, harmonious, sustainable and replicable technologies, development strategies, and rehabilitation measures for the benefit of the leprosy-afflicted and physically challenged. He has worked tirelessly for the rights of leprosy patients in India and has done commendable work on biomass production and low cost, earthquake resistant housing methods. He was an Honorary Member of the General Council, Standing Committee and Executive Committee of Council for Advancement of Peoples Action and Rural Technology (CAPART), National Leprosy Commission, Scientific Advisory Committee to the Union Cabinet's Working Group on Health For All, Agricultural Advisor to Ministry of Economic Affairs, Honorary Consultant and Advisor to the Task Force (Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science & Technology), District Committee of People For Animals (Prevention of Cruelty to Animals) and was a Consultant to Water Distribution & Sanitary Committee, Government of Maharashtra. He has been nominated as Committee Member by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India, to draft a new legislation to replace the Persons with Disabilities Act, 1995.

DR. PRONAB SEN**PRINCIPAL ADVISER, POWER AND ENERGY, PLANNING COMMISSION**

Dr. Sen is Principal Adviser, Power and Energy, in the Planning Commission. He was appointed the first Chief Statistician of India, the functional and technical head of the national statistical system in India, in 2007. From 2007 until 2010, he was Secretary, Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation, Government of India. Earlier in his career, he joined the Government of India as Economic Adviser, Department of Electronics from 1990 until 1994, from where he moved to the Planning Commission. As Adviser/Principal Adviser, Perspective Planning and Statistics & Surveys, he was principal author and coordinator of the Mid-term Appraisal of the Eighth Five Year Plan, the Ninth Five Year Plan, the Mid-term Appraisal of the Ninth Five Year Plan, the Tenth Five Year Plan, and the Mid-term Appraisal of the Tenth Five Year Plan. He has worked as management consultant in Washington D.C., taught at John Hopkins University, Baltimore and Delhi School of Economics. He has also worked at the World Institute for Development Economics Research, Helsinki in 1986 and again in 1989.

**Varad Pande****OFFICER ON SPECIAL DUTY TO THE MINISTER FOR ANVIRONMENT & FORESTS, INDIA**

Varad Pande is the Officer on Special Duty to the Minister of State (I/C), Environment & Forests, Shri Jairam Ramesh since June 2009, supporting the Minister on his entire portfolio related to climate change, environmental governance, forestry, and wildlife. He is Member of the Government's Expert Group on Strategies for Low Carbon Inclusive Growth. Prior to his current role, Varad was Senior Consultant with the strategy and competitiveness consulting firm Monitor Group for over five years, doing projects in Libya, South Africa, South-East Asia, Middle-East and India. At Monitor, Varad led a project to identify and scale-up market-based business models that create social impact in India. He also led a project to design an economic development board for an African country and an analysis for a mega-infrastructure investment in South-east Asia. Varad has also worked for The World Bank on decentralisation and primary education reform in India, co-authoring a social development discussion paper "Making Primary Education Work for India's Rural Poor: A Proposal for Effective Decentralization" with the leading Bank economist, Lant Pritchett. Varad has an MPA in International Development from the Harvard Kennedy School, an MA in Economics from University of Cambridge, and a BA Honours in Economics from St. Stephens College, Delhi.

VIJAY CHADDA
CEO, BHARTI FOUNDATION

Mr Vijay Chadda is the CEO of Bharti Foundation, a position he has held since October 2008. The Foundation is the philanthropic arm of one of India's largest corporates, the Bharti Group, and is focused on bringing quality education to underprivileged children in rural India through 236 schools in villages across five states providing free, quality education to over 30,000 children. He has an Armed Forces background and came into industry after a 20-year career. He has spent 15 years in leadership positions in the travel and tourism industry with large global companies. Mr. Chadda was the first CEO of Carlson Wagonlit Travel in India and was responsible for building the organization and establishing it as India's largest Travel Management Company. As the COO for India and South Asia in Kuoni Travel Group India he successfully managed the restructuring and integration of the erstwhile Sita World Travel which had been acquired by Kuoni, and re-building of its businesses in the area of Corporate Travel, Western Union Money Transfer and Travel & Tourism Education. He has also been associated with premier Travel Industry bodies as a member of the Executive Committee of the Travel Agents Association of India, and as the President of Skai International Delhi, an international industry forum. His last assignment in the Industry was as the CEO of TUI - Le Passage to India.

Mr. Vikram Pant is an investment professional with over 20 years of experience in private equity and finance in India and Europe. Mr. Pant is a Senior Managing Director with IDFC Project Equity, which was set up in 2007 by IDFC to manage the US\$~927MM 'India Infrastructure Fund' ("IIF" see www.idfc.com). IIF invests equity in core infrastructure projects in India's energy, utilities, transportation and telecom sectors, and aims to generate long-term, yield-based income in addition to capital gains.

Prior to joining IDFC, Mr. Pant was a private equity transactor with ABN Amro Capital in Amsterdam, Netherlands from 1999-2007. Over this period, his group invested equity (through seed, expansion, and in LBO transactions) in 17 investments across nine countries. Vikram worked on, amongst others, landmark investments in the German and Polish cable TV sector, in the Bulgarian, Czech and Dutch wireless space, and in Brazilian and Benelux fiber rollouts. Prior to ABN Amro Capital, Mr. Pant worked for six years with ANZ Grindlays Bank in India.

FOUNDER & CHAIRMAN, HANJER BIOTECH ENERGIES

Irfan Furniturewala is the Founder and Chairman of Hanjer Biotech Energies Pvt. Ltd. (Hanjer), a company which operates Municipal Solid Waste ("MSW") processing facilities under long-term concessions from municipal authorities for processing waste before disposal into landfills. Hanjer, which started its first plant five years ago, now has a proven track record across multiple cities in Maharashtra and Gujarat, and aims to be among the largest operators of MSW processing capacities in India. Rapid growth in urbanization and legal imperatives mandating scientific disposal of MSW are driving the requirement for MSW treatment facilities in India. Coupled with strong policy support by the central government for urban infrastructure, this has led to a growing pipeline of MSW processing projects being offered to the private sector, making the business an attractive, long-term growth opportunity.

K. VENKATESH**CEO, L&T INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENTAL PROJECTS LIMITED**

K. Venkatesh is the CEO of L&T Infrastructure Developmental Projects Limited (L&TIDPL), a subsidiary of Larsen & Toubro (L&T, India's largest construction company). L&TIDPL was created in 2006 as a vehicle to house L&T's investments as an owner and developer of Build-Own-Transfer (BOT) infrastructure assets, including roads, ports, airports, and real estate. Under Mr. Venkatesh's stewardship, L&TIDPL has grown to be among the largest and most diversified portfolios of infrastructure assets in India. Mr. Venkatesh has more than three decades of experience spanning the entire infrastructure project lifecycle (across multiple sectors) from structuring, bidding and financial closure through to project management, operations & maintenance and achieving liquidity for project assets.

Ravi Raheja is the Director, K. Raheja group. He has 16 years of industry experience with special focus on the group's real estate and retail arms. He is also actively involved in charting future growth strategies for the group and is currently involved in planning large townships & IT parks in the country. He initiated and introduced retailing sector in India through Shoppers' Stop and Blues Bazaar. Shoppers' Stop successfully created strong brand equity, having achieved the distinction of being the largest retail chain in a short span of five years since inception. Nachiket Mor is the Chairman of SughaVazhvu Healthcare (SughaVazhvu), a Tamil Nadu-based company that focuses on rural healthcare. Prior to his involvement with SughaVazhvu, Mr. Mor spent more than two decades with the ICICI Group (India's largest private sector bank) from 1987 to 2010 in a variety of roles including Corporate Planning, Project Finance, Rural Finance and Treasury. Mr. Mor was a member of ICICI's Board of Directors from 2001 to 2007, when he stepped down from the Board to set up the ICICI Foundation for Inclusive Growth, a philanthropic organization where he served as President until September 2010.

Apart from SughaVazhvu, Mr. Mor is also on the boards of organizations such as CARE India, the ICICI Bank-funded, not-for-profit Institute for Financial Management and Research Trust, and CRISIL. He is a member of three Central Government Committees; the High Powered Expert Committee on Urban Infrastructure, the Technical Advisory Group on Unique Projects and the Committee to Review Implementation of Informal Sector Pensions. In the past Mr. Mor has served as the Chairman of the Fixed Income Money Market and Derivatives Association of India (for two years) and as a Board Member of Wipro Limited (for five years). He is a Yale World Fellow, and while completing his Ph.D. was associated with a Philadelphia based hedge fund (Quantitative Financial Strategies) for three years.

R.D. TULASIRAJ**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, ARAVIND EYE CARE SYSTEM**

R. D. Thulasiraj is part of the leadership team that has built Aravind Eye Care System (Aravind) into the world's largest provider of eye care. Mr. Thulasiraj joined Aravind in 1981 as Administrator and in the ensuing 15 years was instrumental in establishing a sustainable, scalable model of eye care service delivery that has since been studied and replicated by providers across the globe. In 1992, he shifted his focus to capacity building, training and consultancy by setting up the Lions Aravind Institute of Community Ophthalmology, which by 2010 has worked with over 260 hospitals across the globe. With his expertise in setting up culturally relevant solutions to the problem of avoidable blindness, Mr. Thulasiraj has served as an Advisor on several national and international bodies: he was South East Asia's Regional Chairman for the International Agency for the Prevention of Blindness (2000-2005) and the Founder-President of Vision 2020 The Right to Sight: India.
